I know I could use window.innerHeight to get the height of the window, but the width I can't figure out. screen.width (Client width) and screen.height (Client height) give you the screen size. This works on all modern browsers. With window.innerWidth and innerHeight you get the width and height of the view port, which is bigger than the screen in some browser (and for example Opera).
